

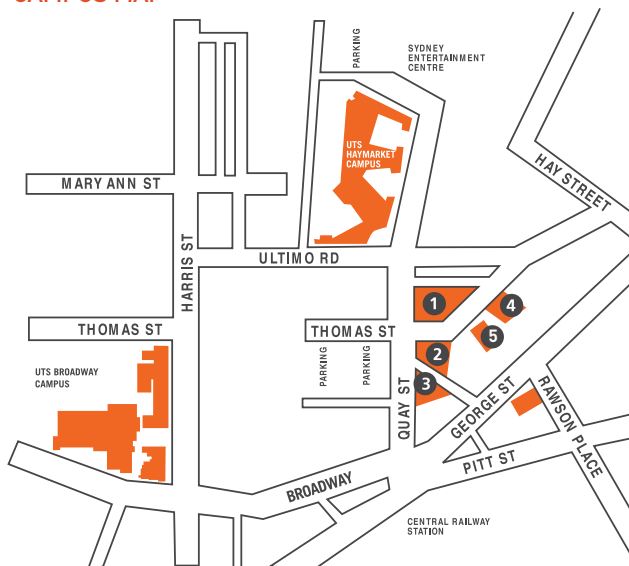
UTS:INSEARCH PROFILE

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- be at least 18 years old
- have an awareness of language and a competence in both written and spoken English which will enable them to undertake the course and prepare for teaching a range of levels
- have the potential to develop the necessary skills to become effective teachers and to complete successfully the written assignments and the assessments of practice teaching.

Candidates should normally have, as a minimum entry requirement, a standard of education equivalent to that required for entry into higher education.

Selection of candidates will be decided by an interview and a test to assess language awareness and aptitude. This process takes about 1½ hours.

ASSESSMENT

There are two assessed components of candidates' performance on the course: Teaching Practice and Written Assignments. Assessment is continuous and integrated, that is, assessment takes place throughout the course and each assessed component contributes to the overall grade. In addition, candidates are required to submit a portfolio of course work consisting of at least four assessed written assignments, materials related to practice teaching and other related documentation as specified by Cambridge ESOL.

TEACHING PRACTICE

The course requires that each trainee do assessed teaching practice for a minimum of six hours throughout the course. This takes place during a two-hour session in which teaching is shared. Trainees progress from teaching shorter to longer lessons.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

INSEARCH has experienced substantial growth in employment opportunities for new teachers, particularly in our off-shore centres in China and Vietnam. A preference is always given to INSEARCH CELTA graduates for teaching positions in these centres.

UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE TEACHING TO ADULTS (CELTA)

The Cambridge CELTA course will provide you with pre-service training in English Language Teaching to Adults. The course is practical, rather than academic in nature and is designed as an introductory course for candidates who have little or no previous experience in English language teaching. The certificate is an internationally recognised qualification and success in the course has enabled many people to obtain their first teaching position. The course is highly regarded by employers for providing sound, initial training.

INSEARCH conducts both full-time and part-time CELTA courses throughout the year. The full-time courses are intensive and extend over four weeks. Participants are expected to devote several hours each evening to study and preparation in addition to day-time sessions. It is therefore important that you arrange to do the course at a time when you do not have other commitments. The part-time courses are less intensive and extend over ten weeks.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course aims to develop your skills in the following areas:

- practical awareness of learners of language and of materials
- practical ability in classroom management and lesson planning
- effective delivery of a range of lesson types
