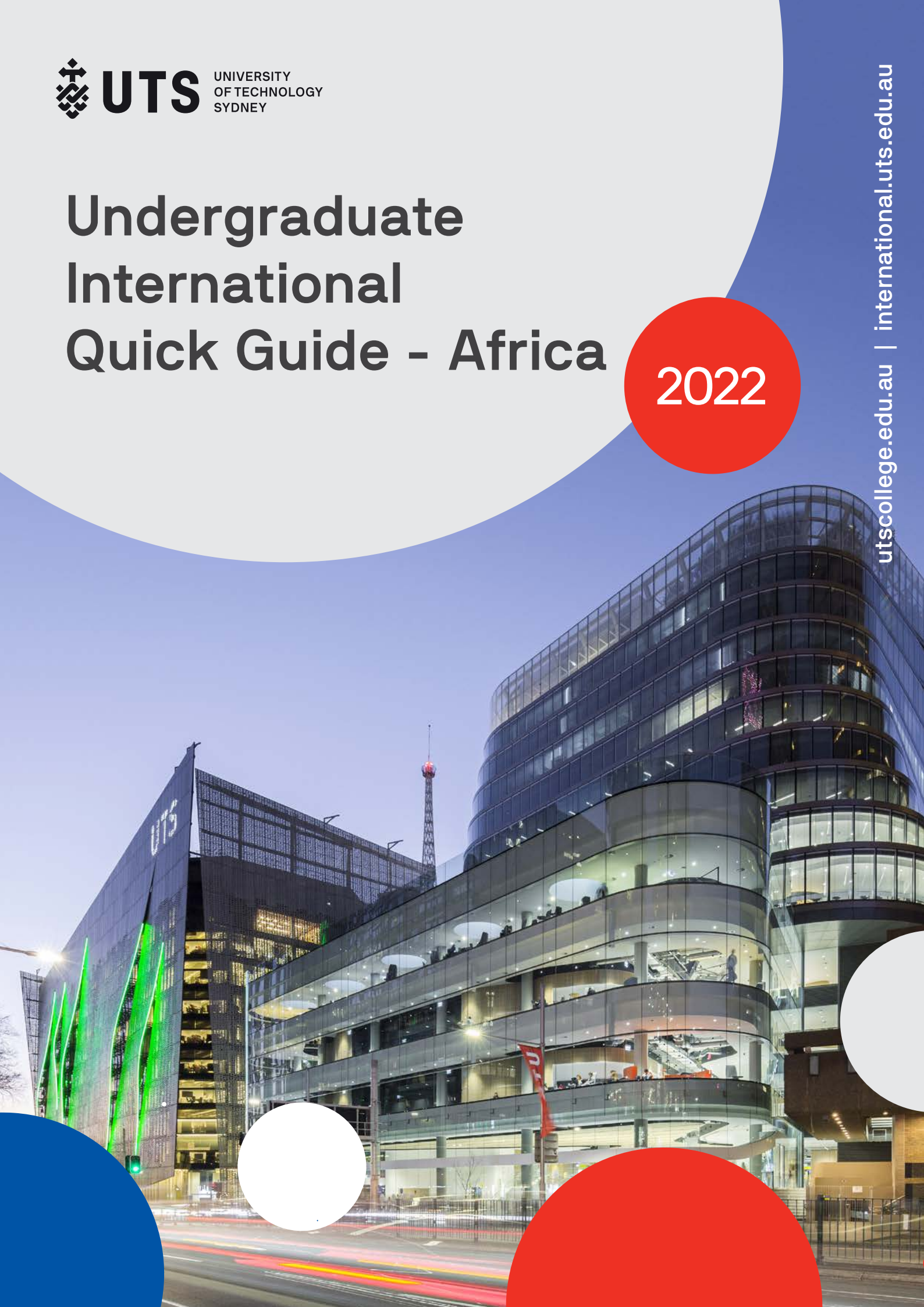

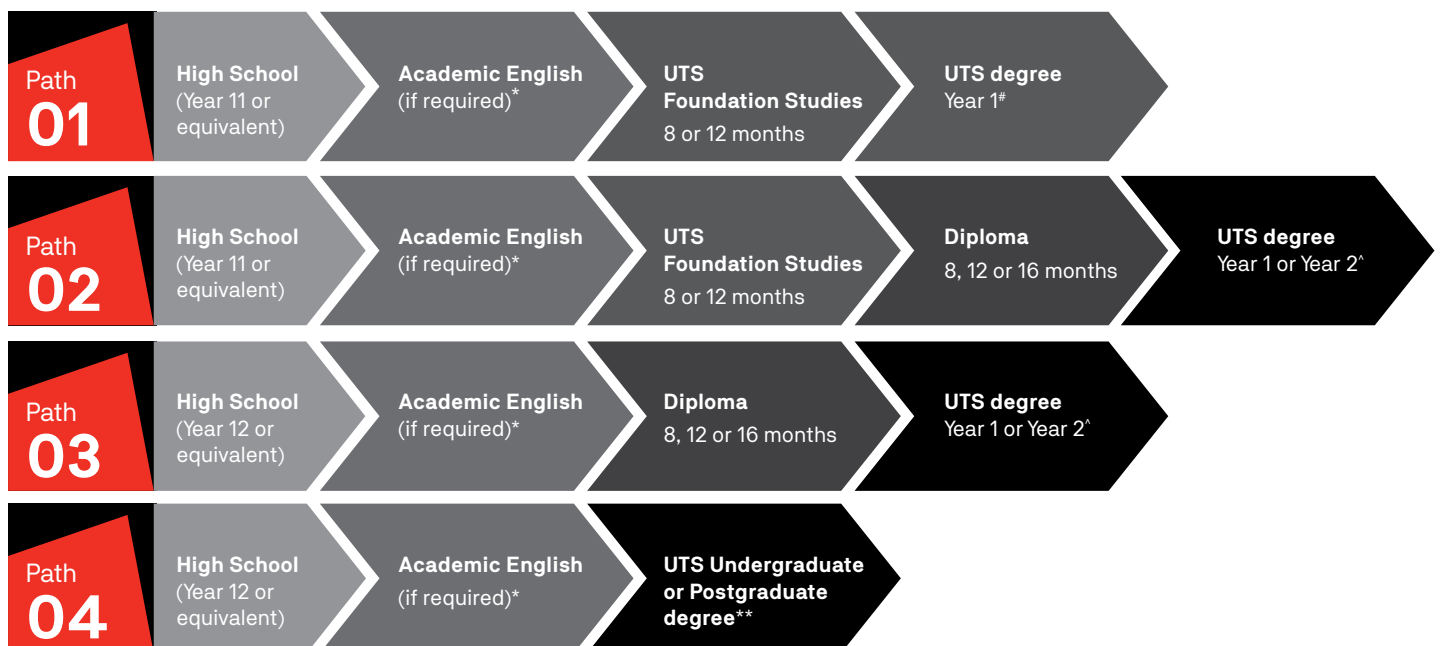
Pre-Master's Program

Our Pre-Master's Program offers entry to 2nd session of selected UTS master's degrees if you don't meet the academic or English requirements for direct entry.

You'll graduate with a recognised graduate certificate and 24 credit points towards your UTS master's degree.

Scholarships

UTS College to UTS Pathway Scholarship
