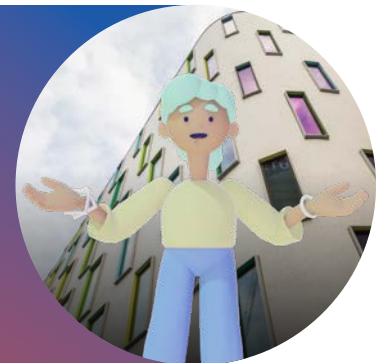

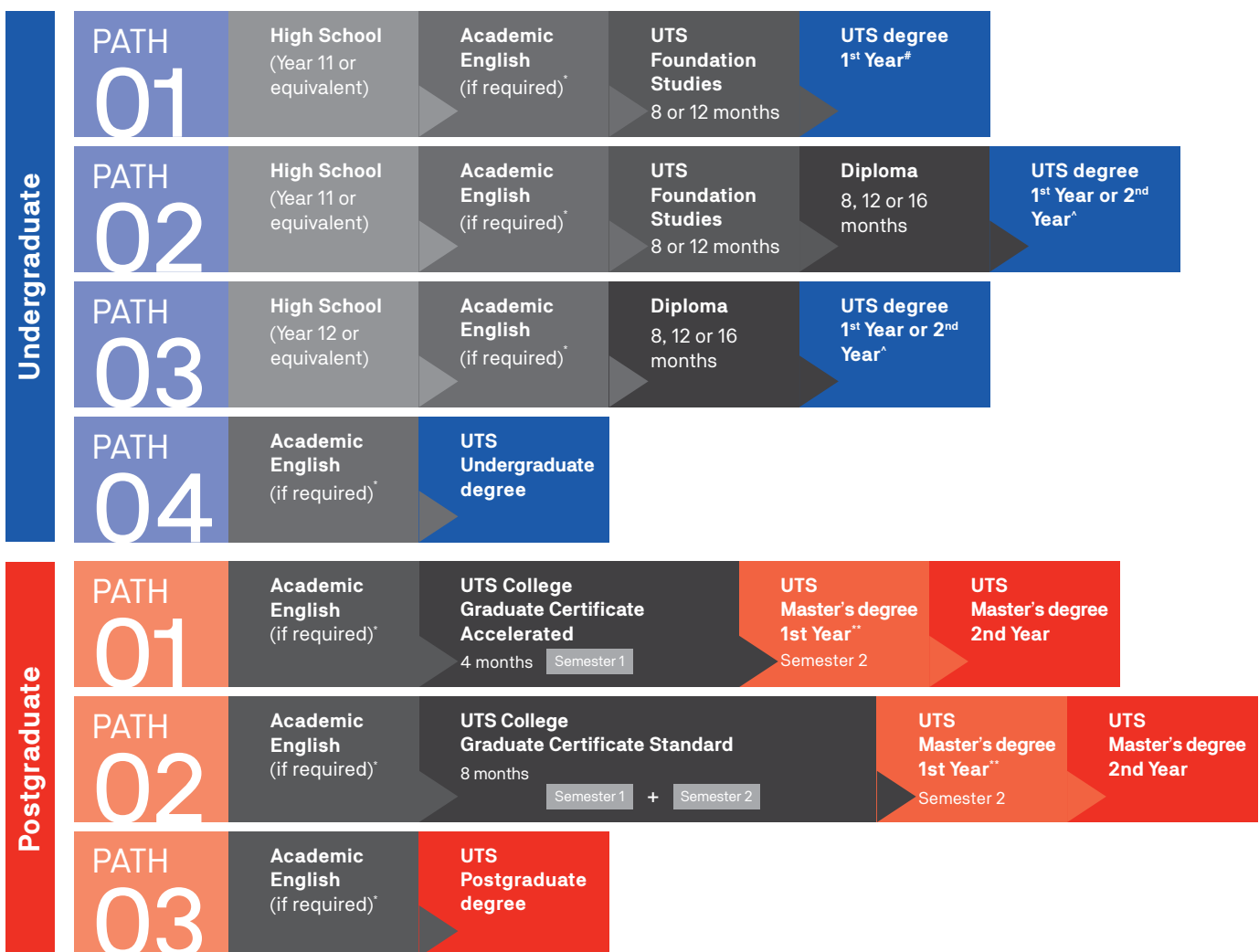

The international student processing fee of A\$250 is payable once an international student applies to UTS College for the first time and is non-refundable.

Subject failure:

The fees are based on no subject failures. Any subject that needs to be undertaken a second time will require payment of the relevant subject fee.

UTS College package discounts:

A UTS College academic package is comprised of a UTS Foundation Studies program and a UTS College diploma course but can also include a preliminary English course.
