


Over the course of one or two semesters**, you'll:

On successful completion, you'll achieve a graduate certificate qualification and gain 24 credit points of advanced standing towards a Master of Strategic Communication (Extension), a Master of Media Practice and Industry (Extension) or a Master of Advanced Journalism (Extension) in the School of Communication, Faculty of Arts and Social Science at UTS. There, you'll gain industry exposure, practical experience, and the skills you need to build a global career in media and communication.

Information Technology and Engineering

The UTS College Graduate Certificate in Technology Practice will set you on the right path for a career in IT or Engineering.

You'll also develop a full industry project proposal, perfect your English and academic skills, and gain new industry perspectives. On successful completion, you'll gain entry and 24 credit points of advanced standing towards a:

- Master of Information Technology (Extension), Master of Information Technology, or Master of Data Science and Innovation, or
- Master of Engineering (Extension), or Master of Professional Engineering





Pathways to UTS
