


# Domestic Student Recruitment Guide

For domestic students, entry to UTS College does not require an ATAR. Instead, it is based on the student's subject average. of English and their best 3 board developed courses.

For example, Sam's UTS College subject average is calculated as English Standard (65%), plus their best 3 board-developed courses of Earth and Environmental Science (71%), Mathematics Standard 2 (73%) and Japanese Beginners (68%). UTS subject average (65+71+73+68) / 4 = 69.25%. With a score of 69.25%, Sam is eligible to apply for a standard diploma (min. 67%).

### **Application checklist**

- Transcript of studies showing subjects and results
- Completion certificate (if completed)
- Copy of your passport, birth certificate, citizenship certificate or visa
- Any other relevant documentation to support application

#### Domestic vs onshore students

#### What's the same?

• Entry requirements and program fees are the same across both student groups.

#### What's different?

- Domestic students do not have to pay upfront fees. They are eligible for FEE-HELP if they are Australian citizens.
- Articulation is different. Domestic students need a minimum GPA to articulate to UTS. Refer to:

#### How to accept

Students need to accept their offer via the Student Portal so the help you can offer here will be limited:

Before they accept their offer, please ensure they have completed these actions:

Set up Unique Student Identifier (USI). They will need to upload legal identification to do this. Determine payment option:

- a. Upfront payment is available to all students.
- b. Defer payment of fees via FEE-HELP. This is available to eligible domestic students only. Students are advised to read the FEE-HELP Q&A section in their offer letter before making a decision.

Check they have the following to upload to the student portal where required:

Conditional offer = check any outstanding documentation as indicated on Page 3 the offer letter. If the student is under 18 years, upload the Acceptance form found on page 10 of the offer letter in addition to any outstanding documentation. Both student and parent/legal guardian will need to sign and date the form. Print, scan, and attach the form in the Portal.\*

#### Diploma fees

- Accelerated (8 months): \$35,000
- Standard (12 months): \$35,000
- Extended (16 months): \$44,000

Fees are correct at the time of publishing. UTS College reserves the right to vary fees at any time. FEE-HELP is available to domestic students.

#### Articulation requirements for each diploma

Diploma of Animation Production, Business, Communication, Design & Architecture, Engineering or Information Technology is based on the required Grade Point Average.


