How to accept your offer

If your application is successful, we will send you a letter of offer (or a provisional offer letter if there are any outstanding entry requirements or any outstanding documentation).

Your letter of offer will contain detailed instructions on how to accept your offer. In order to secure your offer, you will need to accept it and either pay your fees or apply for FEE-HELP (if eligible).
