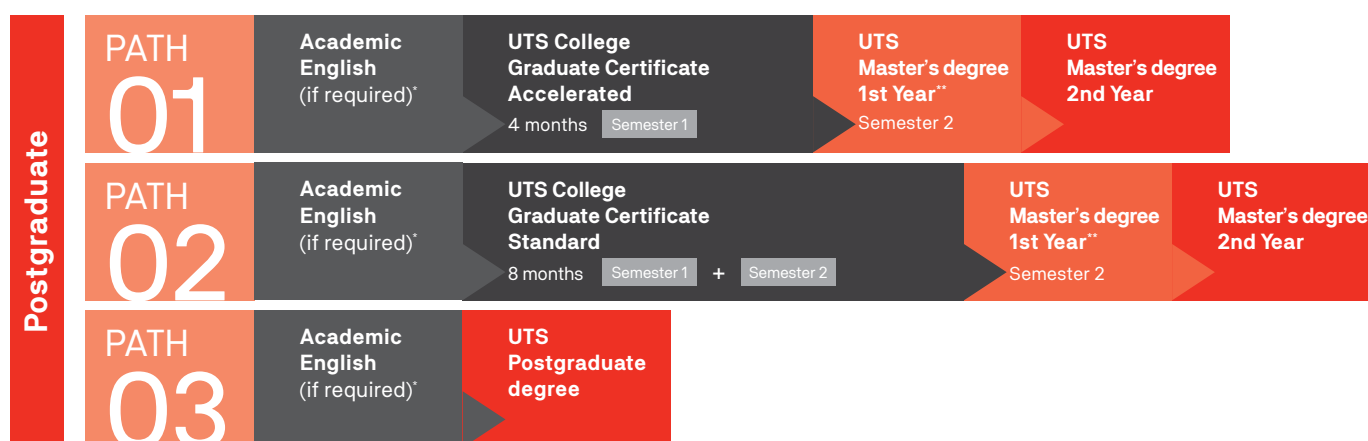
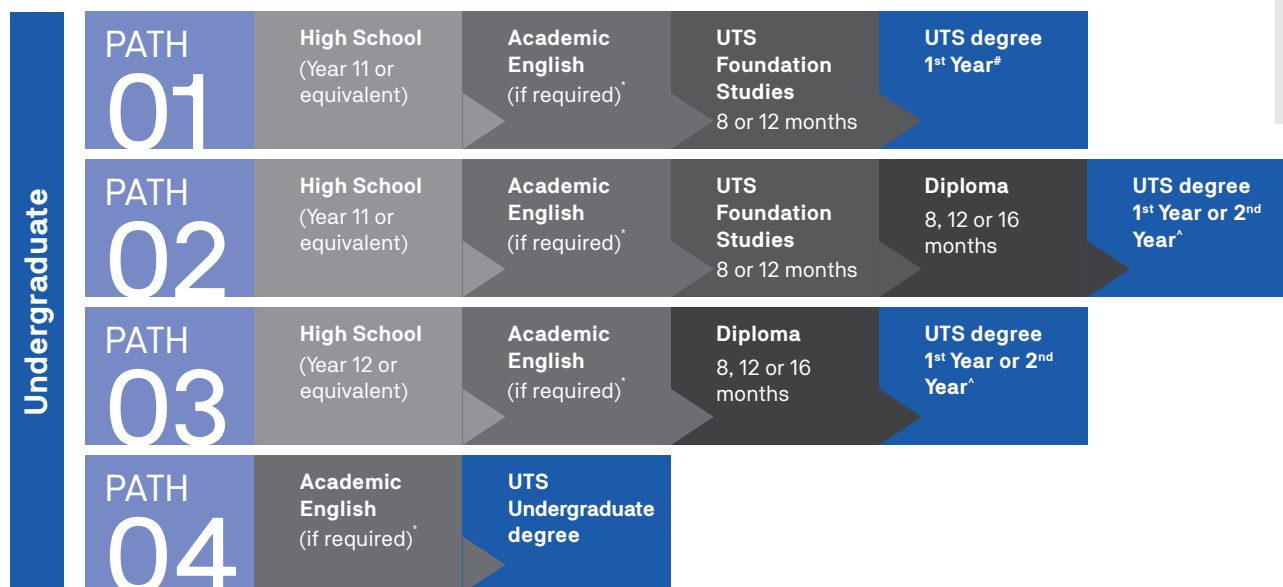

**Processing fees:**  
The international student processing fee of A\$250 is payable once an international student applies to UTS College for the first time and is non-refundable.

**Subject failure:**  
The fees are based on no subject failures. Any subject that needs to be undertaken a second time will require payment of the relevant subject fee.

**UTS College package discounts:**  
A UTS College academic package is comprised of a UTS Foundation Studies program and a UTS College diploma course but can also include a preliminary English course. Students undertaking a UTS College academic package will receive a 5% discount off the total English tuition fees and will also receive a 5% discount off their diploma course fees when packaged with a UTS Foundation Studies program.
